Completion of 500kV overhead transmission line construction across Thailand and Laos

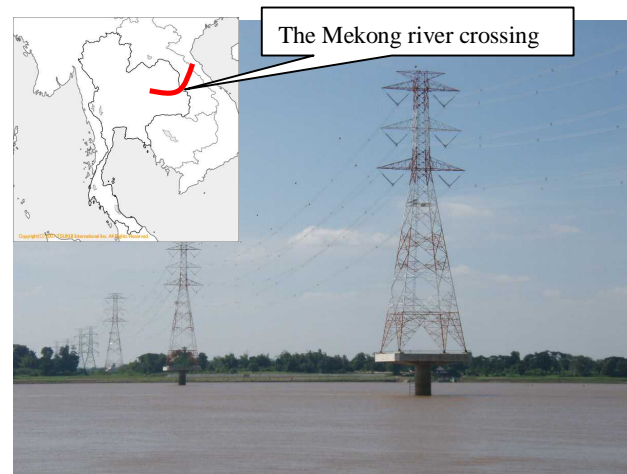
J-Power Systems Corp. has successfully completed the 500kV overhead transmission line project, which was ordered by EGAT(Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand) in Thailand and NTPC(Nam Theum 2 Power Company, Ltd.) in Laos.

This project is to transmit electric power from Nam Theum 2 hydropower plant (capacity 1,070MW) to Roi Et 2 substation owned by EGAT in Thailand across the Mekong river, and is desired to be completed in order to meet increasing electric power demand in Thailand.

Out of the total route length 297km, 161km is in Thailand, 134km is in Laos and 2km is crossing the Mekong river.

The construction started in 2006, Recently the commissioning test was completed, and the transmission line was taken over by the customer.

As the Mekong area still needs electric power infrastructure, J-Power Systems Corp. would be continuing to contribute the economic development in this area.
